

Storm Safety

When Aberdeen enters into its "severe weather" time of the year (the most prevalent months are April, May and June), the following basic severe weather information is helpful.

Aberdeen is located in Brown County and the following counties that border Brown County are:

Dickey - ND	North
McPherson	Northwest
Edmunds	West
Faulk	Southwest
Spink	South
Day	East

Tornado Watch

Is when the conditions are right for a possible tornado to form.

Tornado Warning

When a tornado has been spotted in the area. The warning sirens will sound to indicate that all persons should take cover.

In the case of an actual warning, when the sirens are sounding, Front Desk personnel shall alert all guests and personnel by intercom or by calling each occupied guest room and each common area. All guests are asked to proceed calmly to the main floor where hotel employees will direct you further. Front Desk personnel will give the "all clear" signal at which time you may proceed back to your guest room.

Guest Emergency Procedures

- The staff of the Ramkota Hotel have been trained and assigned specific duties during emergency situations.
- Under emergency conditions, it is advisable to remain in your room with your corridor door closed and all windows closed, unless directed otherwise.

- 4. Remain calm, permit the professionals to handle the emergency, evacuate only when requested, use emergency stairwells only.
